






FIRST FLOOR (214.) linguistics, literary studies, fiction, language books, dictionaries, cinema, theatre, special collections






SECOND FLOOR (314.) Social sciences: philosophy, religion, politics, economics, ethnography, communication, history

Cambridge Core is a platform for Cambridge University Press' academic content. The book and journal content has been brought together for the first time on Cambridge Core: a sophisticated, high-performance replacement for Cambridge Journals Online and Cambridge Books Online.

Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts (LISTA)

Offers well-researched information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment: global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling, and more.







The JSTOR Essential Collection provides scientific content in the area of humanities and social sciences, it contains 682 journals. All issues, from volume 1 / issue 1, are provided for every journal up to the moving wall (or embargo), including all previous and related titles.



MathSciNet



MathSciNet indexes and abstracts more than 3100 periodicals and more than 7500 books, conference proceedings, theses, and technical reports. Both English and foreign language materials in the fields of mathematics, statistics, computer science, and related fields are included.



ProQuest



ProQuest Central brings together the most used databases to create the most comprehensive, diverse, and relevant multidisciplinary research database available. It provides access to databases across all major subject areas, including business, health and medical, social sciences, arts and humanities, education, science and technology, and religion. The collection includes thousands of full-text scholarly journals, newspapers, magazines, dissertations, working papers, and market reports all together on a powerful, user-friendly platform.

SpringerLink is one of the world's leading databases for high-quality STM (Science, Technology and Medicine) documents. It provides full-text online access to Springer's journals, e-books and reference works included in our subscriptions and "preview-only" access to materials outside of it. Web of Science



The **Web of Science** is a combination of three databases: Science Citation Index Expanded, Social Sciences Citation Index, Arts & Humanities Citation Index. It indexes more than 12,000 peer-reviewed journals, providing complete bibliographic data and author abstracts. Live links to electronic journals with full text are included for some publishers.

Visual History Archive



USC Shoah Foundation's **Visual History Archive** allows users to search through and view more than 54,000 video testimonies of survivors and witnesses of genocide.

The interviews have been conducted in 65 countries and 43 languages. Each collection adds context for the others, providing multiple pathways to learn from the eyewitnesses of history across time, locations, cultures and sociopolitical circumstances. The archive, which is searchable by the minute, contains invaluable material for research and education.
